COURSE DESCRIPTION

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) guidelines.

This unit applies to all persons who may be required to provide CPR, in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings.

PRE-ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

This unit of competency has no mandatory entry requirements; however, CSI have the following specific requirements for students wishing to enrol:

- Be at least 18 years of age.
- Hold a level of language, literacy, numeracy and digital skills to at least a year 12 level. Program information material is written and includes some numerical calculations. Crescent Scholars Institute will issue a Language, Literacy, Numeracy & Digital Skills (LLND) assessment.

To successfully complete this course, a student must have the physical ability to perform:

- At least 2 minutes of uninterrupted single rescuer cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) (5 cycles of both compressions and ventilations (rescue breaths) on an adult resuscitation manikin placed on the floor; and
- At least 2 minutes of uninterrupted single rescuer CPR (5 cycles both compressions and ventilations) on an infant resuscitation manikin placed on a firm surface.

Students must be willing to participate in practical scenarios and AED training

Once it has been determined by our office that all pre-entry requirements have been satisfied, a confirmation of enrolment will be provided to you.
